Nestled on benchland overlooking the Similkameen Valley, Seven Stones is a 100% estate winery well known for its full-bodied red wines, a spectacular view and its mysterious caves. Built with a solid reputation for blends and single varietal reds, Seven Stones is fast becoming a leader in the wine industry by releasing wines that are mature and well aged. Winery owner and Winemaker George Hanson is passionate about every aspect of winemaking beginning with careful attention to the growth cycles of grapes to the aging of wines in Seven Stones world class cave cellars.

Tasting Notes

This right bank style of wine is multi layered with aromas of ripe plum, blackberry, ground coffee, and cedar. These pleasures are followed by flavors of ripe plum, raspberry, coffee, chocolate and real vanilla. This wine has a soft velvety mouthfeel and a complex long lingering finish that is cushioned by juicy velvety tannins.

Winemaker's Notes

Crushed berries and juice were cold soaked for 4 days with natural yeast to extract flavors. Fermentation was slowed by temperature control to preserve aromas and to extend maceration effects. This wine was gently pressed, not fined or filtered.

Vintage Notes

Early spring, warm and dry summer with a warm/dry extended fall.

Cooperage

70% new French oak and 30% new American oak for 18 months.
